Many of our clients are dual diagnosis and cannot identify which came first, the mental health issue or the substance abuse issue. We look at each client holistically and although many therapeutic techniques are applicable to both mental health and substance abuse clients, a behavioral approach is also encouraged with substance abuse clients.
