The Peer Support Expansion Initiative program consists of students taking the CRS Core Training, followed by approximately 100 hours of Enhanced Trainings and a supervised Field Placement. The program prepares individuals to obtain the CRS credential and provides support with job readiness and employment opportunities. Certified Recovery Specialists are people in long-term recovery who want to use their experience to help others. They work hard to assist individuals in accessing and sustaining recovery from Substance Use Disorders.

Program Breakdown:

- Core Training: 66 Class Hours + 12 Hours of Homework
- Enhanced Trainings with Field Placements: Approximately 100 Hours
