CFRS Training Qualifications:

Minimum of a high school diploma/ GED. Proof of education is required. Applicants must either work or live in Pennsylvania at the time of application.

This curriculum is for professionals who are interested in training to become a Certified Family Recovery Specialist (CFRS) through the Pennsylvania Certification Board.
