CERTIFIED RECOVERY SPECIALIST (CRS) CERTIFIED FAMILY RECOVERY SPECIALIST (CFRS) SPRING TRAINING SERIES

This training is for professionals interested in applying for the Certified Recovery Specialist (CRS), the Certified Family Recovery Specialist (CFRS) and/or the Certified Recovery Specialist Supervisor (CRSS) through the Pennsylvania Certification Board (PCB). Curriculum consists of 78 instructional hours; including 66 in class hours and 12 hours of homework, designed to prepare Recovery Specialists for work in the behavioral health field. Course instructor will guide learners through all PCB pre-enrollment requirements and provide a Learner Manual prior to the training. This training is FREE.
